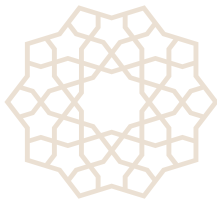
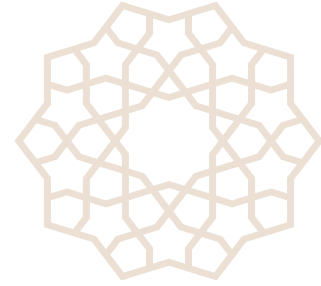
The Union's Basic References:

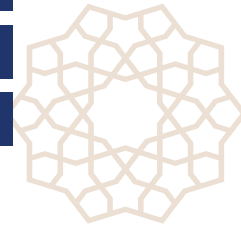

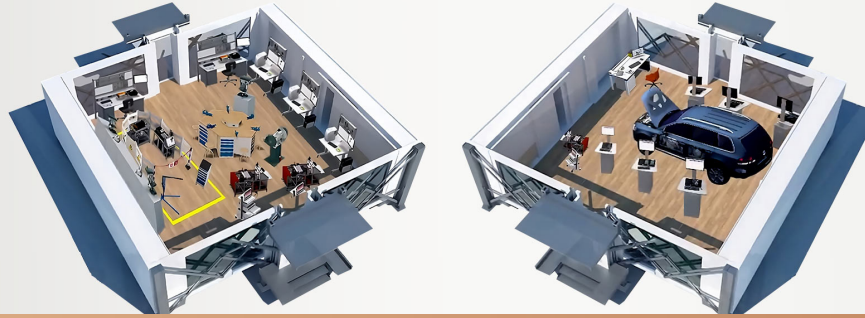


Mehnaty Mostaqbali (My career, my future)



Technical education and vocational training are the main sources of professionally trained technical workers supply to the labor market. Such workers play an important role in societies and countries development. Due to the importance of its outputs and its impact on the sustainable development of any country, especially the developing ones, which are looking forward to a promising future, this type of education receives special attention in most developed and developing countries.





1 - Fixed vocational training center project:

The project aims to combat unemployment, promote the professional level of young men and women, provide real job opportunities, and meet the needs of the labor market for trained manpower in various specializations. Our strategy focuses on finding cadres of technicians and skilled workers without having to establish multi-year institutes. Rather, we have gone for expanding vocational training programs, and organizing skills to practice trades and professional specialization through high-quality courses according to each specialization's standards. The study in our centers is practical and limited to 9-12 months only. In addition, it takes into account the local community's privacy and culture and the host country laws and regulations in order to make the training process possible and able to face any challenge, and prepare outstanding technical cadres and skilled workers, taking into account the labor market requirements and creating real job opportunities to resist unemployment.

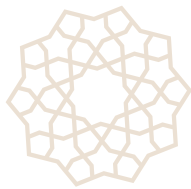


2 - Mobile training center project:

As suggested by its name, mobile technical centers, which are completely and radically different from traditional centers, are based on the Folding House principle. It is a mobile building, carried by a vehicle, and contains the components and elements that form a complete technical school structure without ignoring any of the educational and training elements, which may negatively affect the educational process. This is a large-space building; its area can be triple the original transported area. Folding implies that it is a foldable building, i.e., it is originally folded, however, it can be self-unfolded to form the larger building, the building's walls and floors are self-unfolded like an umbrella or an accordion, in just ten minutes, you can see the whole building formed right in front of you.

Mobile training center project features:

- Save the time spent in building traditional centers, and use it to educate a larger number of students, which positively affects the project productivity and feasibility.
- Save time and cost of transportation from/to the centers for the students and their families.
- Save the students the trouble of reaching the centers' headquarters under various difficult or dangerous circumstances.
- Save the cost of building many centers in different places.
- Reach the largest number of learners near their place, which encourages them to enroll in school.
- Not having to create an electricity, water and sanitation infrastructure, as in traditional schools.
- The center relies mainly on e-contents and virtual laboratories, and works using cloud, so that students can complete their studies even after the centers have moved to another place.
- In the event that the center's location rendered inappropriate due to weather, political or any other conditions, it can be moved at any time within the same region or city.
- Ability to add any number of partition walls to change the place layout depending on usage and activities; accordingly, it serves different goals.
- Easy control of space and number of floors.
- The mobile center may be dedicated to several activities, all the equipment can be stored in a central common store, and then devices are moved to the center according to the activities and courses, which offers great degree of flexibility.
- Ability to equip the center with all the tools that guarantee active and interactive training.

Ea'qati Entelaqi (My disability, my start)



A series of projects that have been launched pursuant to the principles of equal opportunities and education for all, in the Muslim Scout Platform for Humanitarian Services initiative's belief that education, training and rehabilitation are inherent rights of every individual, including persons with special needs, as they have the right to educational, training and rehabilitation opportunities that are compatible with their different special circumstances, to make them a pillar of sustainable development, taking into account the statistics indicating that persons with special needs, especially those with disabilities, are not less than 13% of total population, with this percentage rises by up to 15% or more in developing societies.

This group is the center of attention of “The Muslim Scout Platform for Humanitarian Services” initiative, as it believes that paying attention to this group is a religious imperative according to the instructions of our religion, Islam; a social and civilized imperative, as they are part of the fabric of society and their good conditions reflect well on the whole society; an educational imperative because they are our sons, they must be cared for and integrated into their environment, for they are an essential element of society and has the right to be well educated and raised; a political imperative pursuant to the principles of equal opportunities and education for all; and an economic imperative, for it is not a small group, proper employment will turn them into productive people that contribute to the implementation of the concept of sustainable development.

1- Use of Assistive Technology:

Use of ICT (assistive technology) project aims to enable persons with disabilities to make the most of such technology through a full package of technological tools, contents and applications that assist in the development of mental, social, linguistic, sensory and motor skills of persons with disabilities. The project develops integrated solutions regarding the uses of ICT for persons with disabilities, through future visions, services, special educational and training programs, and creative solutions to education and training problems, which contribute to redefining and redesigning the educational and training content provided to them, so that information become more accessible. In addition, practical application and training through various educational practices form their personality, organize the process of learning and the way they acquire social knowledge and effective communication skills. The project also provides educational and training services that seek to sharpen their mental abilities and rehabilitate them so that they do not face psychological and educational difficulties, rather integrate easily into society and become productive members thereof, not a burden on their families and society.



2 - Training Programs:

The initiative provides an integrated, specialized and diversified training road map project, which covers three main axes of the persons with disabilities system, as follows:



1 - Axis I:

Integrated and specialized training programs for this area staff, to develop their skills (training axis). Training aims to train cadres of skilled and competent trainers who are good at qualifying persons with disabilities in accordance with training international standards. They are the cornerstone of a new generation of reliable trainers in the target local communities. The training program offers many different courses, lectures and workshops as follows:



Specialized training courses:

- Speech-language pathologist preparation course
- Autism specialist
- Audiologist preparation course
- Learning disability specialist preparation course
- Early intervention specialist preparation course
- Sign language specialist
- Testing specialist preparation course
- Occupational therapist preparation course
- Blind rehabilitation specialist preparation course
- Educational counseling specialist preparation course
- Behavior modification specialist preparation course
- Special education specialist preparation course
- Talent specialist preparation course
- Montessori course

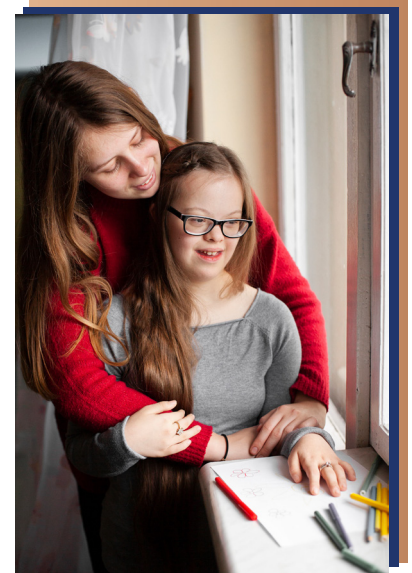
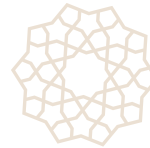

2 - Axis II



This axis provides training for the parents of persons with disabilities (awareness axis). The general objective of this axis is to educate parents of persons with special needs on disability and its issues, so that they are able to deal with their kids properly in a positive atmosphere that achieves psychological adjustment for both of them. This project aims to provide training courses and recorded e-training content through the platform regularly, they are accessible by signing in the platform. This content includes but not limited to:

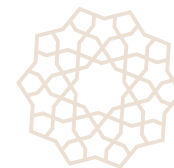

3 - Axis III:

This axis addresses the institutions for persons with disabilities (care axis), and its general objective is to provide integrated and specialized training programs for such institutions to develop their staff skills, and make sure that they comply with the applicable international standards. The provided courses and programs include but not limited to:

- Build institutional capacities for effective communication with persons with disabilities
- Build school capacities for an improved and safe learning environment
- Build professional factories workers capacities to deal with persons with special needs
- Qualification of persons with disabilities for the labor market.
- Pioneering international experiences in qualification of persons with special needs for the labor market
- Training packages and their role in the educational and vocational preparation process
- Requirements of the labor market and adjustment of disability and the different segments of persons with disabilities to such requirements
- Enterprise operational plan
- Assessment, quality and qualification for accreditation
- Capacity building to upgrade the efficiency and capabilities of various governmental and non-governmental institutions staffs, and raise awareness of disability issues in order to have awareness of disability issues among media workers, communicate effectively with persons with disabilities and enhance their media capabilities.



3 - Portal for Diagnosis and Assessment of Persons with Disabilities:

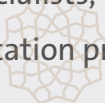
Diagnosis and assessment of children with disabilities is vitally important to the workers in the field of disability, for they play great role in determining the educational services to be provided to the child within the individual educational plan, after identifying their mental abilities and strengths in order to enhance and invest them in their social, psychological and educational development, and then follow up their development in various fields from time to time by assessment of the individual plan.

Absence of a portal for diagnosis and assessment of persons with disabilities results in many problems, including:

- Specialists act individually, which results in diagnosis problems and errors.
- Absence of an e-file for each disabled person from the beginning.
- Lack of a clear follow-up mechanism agreed upon by parents and specialized bodies, including centers and specialists, which delays the educational and rehabilitation process.

Project services are specifically targeted at:

- Ministries of development and social affairs
- Ministries of Education
- Kindergartens
- Civil society institutions for persons with disabilities
- Persons with disabilities rehabilitation centers
- Persons with disabilities rehabilitation specialists
- Families of persons with disabilities



4 - Equipment of integrated rehabilitation centers with assistive tools and devices (different disabilities) project:

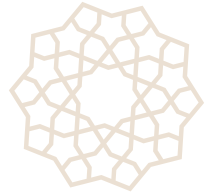
Inclusive centers, especially in developed countries that have set a precedent in the field of care and special education in disability inclusive centers, are role models. It is worth noting that the success stories emanating of these centers depend mainly on highly advanced technological tools that help yield great results with respect to development of persons with disabilities skills. The project aims to provide centers with the following tools:

- **AAC:** Alternative pointing tools, sound amplification and mixing equipment, voice typing keyboards, and communication techniques software training
- **Learning and attention disorders aids:** Noise canceling headphones, reading aids and writing and reading assistance software
- **Sensory integration and activation tools:** Multimodal sensory systems, e-sensory belts, sensory games
- **Alternative computer input devices:** Head and eye trackers, alternate keyboards, Sip-and-puff systems, and voice recognition software
- **Blind reading, writing and browsing tools**

Menhaty (My Scholarship)



This initiative is interested in supporting students by providing educational scholarships and training opportunities for those in need, giving them the opportunity for education and training to make them able to build a better future for themselves, and their families, society and nation.

Applications of those desiring to benefit from the project are received online on: www.msihs.org. Selection depends on the students GPA and financial situation. The project and its partners contribute to providing scholarships, qard hassan (benevolent loans), or one-time aids, as the case may be.



Scholarships Restrictions:

- Major restrictions: Candidates have to choose majors most in demand in the labor market, not stagnant ones. The same applies to professions training courses
- Candidates have to apply to one or more of the initiative's partner universities, colleges and training centers.

Target group:

- Needy students, refugees and IDPs
- Needy persons, refugees and IDPs who desire to learn a profession that that help them earn decent living



Scholarships courses and training programs:

Scholarships for two-year diploma technical schools, and 3,6 or 9-month training scholarships for accelerated vocational courses in various programs are provided.

Project Relevance:

- Help distinguished refugees, IDPs, and the poor, to have higher education and training that help them earn decent living.

Types of Scholarships:

- Academic excellence scholarships
- The IOC poor member states scholarships
- Full ride and partial scholarships for refugees, IDPs and the poor of both sexes.



Malath (Sanctuary)

The Sanctuary provides free palliative and humane care home services for patients and their families regardless of age, sex, nationality, religion or race, ensuring that their last days are full of comfort and dignity. The services provided by the project include medical, nursing, social and psychological support, in addition to counseling for patients at the end-of-life stage and their families. The project primarily prioritizes comfort and quality of life by reducing pain and suffering and fulfilling health, emotional, and spiritual needs of patients at the end-of-life stage, in addition to supporting their families.



What is Palliative Care?



Palliative care is a multidisciplinary approach to specialized medical and nursing care for patients with end-stage disease.

The project



The Sanctuary is intended for any patient needs care and support. It introduces a new global approach to patient care using palliative care that improve patients' quality of life when medications fail to cure them.

Palliative care is provided to patients to help them live their last days as comfortable and dignified as possible, with no pain and suffering. Palliative care also pays great attention to the humanitarian aspects, including physical, spiritual, social and psychological aspects of the patients and their families.

Moreover, the project provides palliative care to patients at homes in case of severe illnesses, with full support to their families, and great emphasis upon the patient's quality of life, regardless of duration.

When illness gets worse and out of control of the treatment facilities to achieve healing or control patient deterioration, here comes the role of palliative care to replace the traditional treatment methods. This stage provides the best possible quality of life for patients and their families by controlling pain and other symptoms, and supporting their psychological, social and spiritual needs, which are rarely taken into account in traditional treatment methods. The concept of palliative care has evolved over years, it means a combination of medical and emotional care that is provided for patients and their families. Medical care focuses on controlling pain and physical issues while emotional care maintains the patient's mental awareness and psychological purity.





Project Relevance:

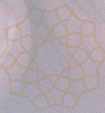


The Sanctuary is vitally important, for it preserves the dignity and privacy of patients. As we believe that integrated care and permanent support is a critical need of patients, we are keen to provide them with full care, and even enable them to stay at home, if they so choose, to be surrounded by their families and loved ones. We also use the latest scientific methods to control pain and physical symptoms, and improve patients' quality of life so that they live in comfort, without pain and suffering and preserve their dignity at their last days.

Project Objectives:

- Relieve symptoms, reduce pain, physical and psychological stress at any stage of the disease.
- Improve the quality of life for patients and their families.
- Provide palliative care at home when disease progresses, and full support for patients and their families. focus on patients' quality of life regardless of duration.

Education and training volunteer groups:

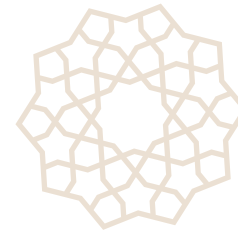
- Provide the most in need or mediocre students with virtual offline or online education classes

- Help and contribute to collecting and distributing clothes to the persons in need with their specialized associations partners

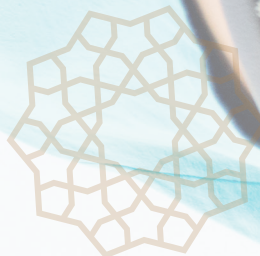






Initiative Objectives:

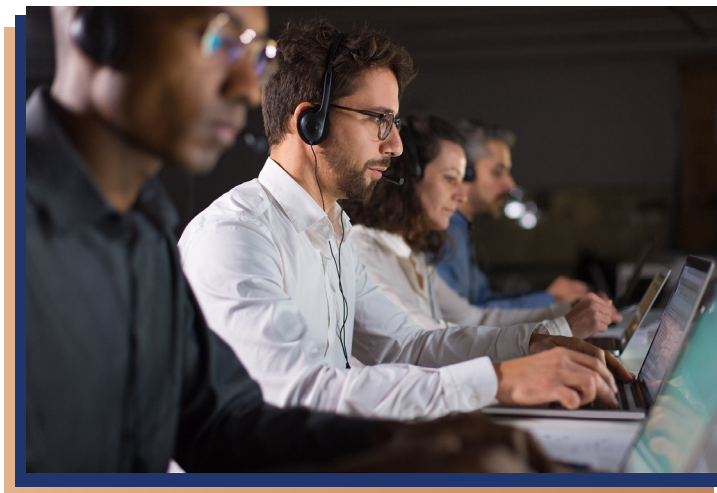

Chaptology

Online volunteering project (Chaptology) under the slogan of “One Volunteer World”. Bel'Araby (In Arabic)



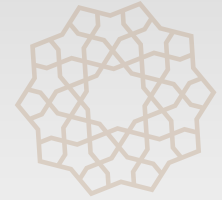

He has also said: {In a clear Arabic language} [26:195]. Therefore, the Union seeks, in conjunction with experts, to teach Arabic to non-native speakers, as Arabic is a universal language, and a primary approved language at the OIC and the UN. The platform provides two Arabic language programs as follows:

Second Program

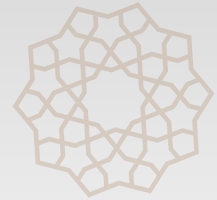


My Quran

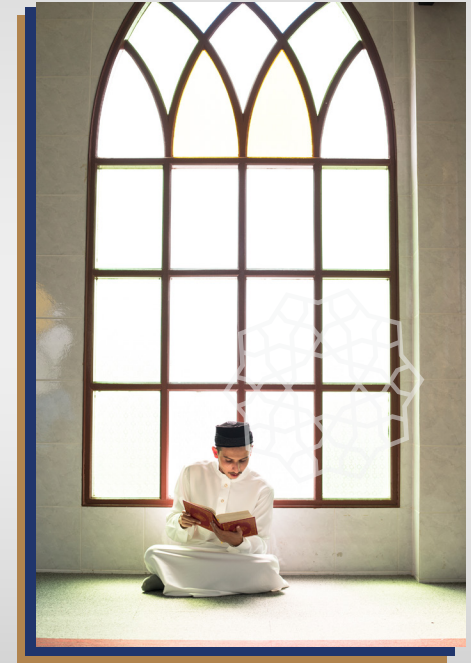
Bunian (Eonstruction)
